

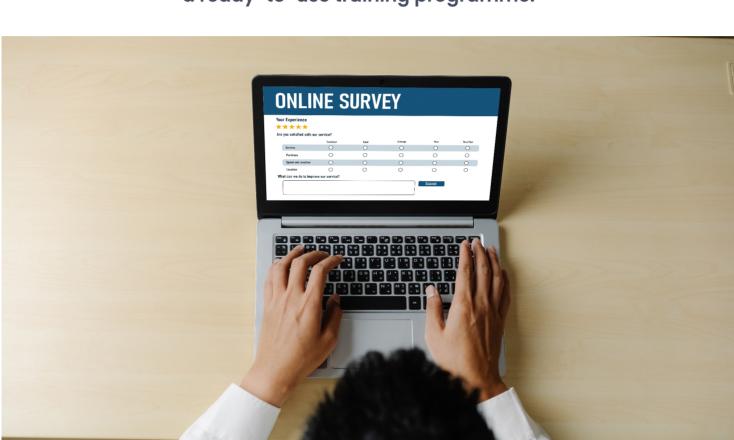
SHOEpro stands for Integrated Action for Building VET Curricula and Training Opportunities in Croatia & Portugal for Digital and Green Transformation in the Footwear Sector



From project launch to concrete progress

Since the launch of the ShoePro project in October 2024, partners from the Croatian Employers' Association (HUP), the Faculty of Textile Technology, and the Portuguese Footwear Technological Centre (CTCP) have been working together to design innovative and agile curricula for the footwear sector.

Following the successful kick-off meeting and collaborative workshop in Portugal last November, the project has now moved into a decisive phase, transforming collected data and industry feedback into a ready-to-use training programme.



Surveying the industry: key insights

From **26 May to 6 June 2025**, ShoePro partners surveyed 18 Croatian and 11 Portuguese footwear company representatives to assess the state of digitalization, sustainability, and innovation.

Highlights include:

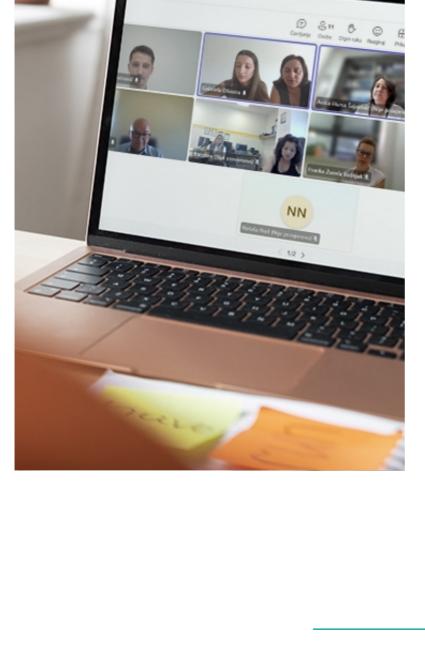
